Tuesdays at 6:30 with Father Young *both* are at St. Alphonsus Rectory 2618 Boies Avenue, Davenport.





Announcements - Good Friday is the First Friday of April. There will probably be a video presentation on the Shroud of Turin following the Liturgy on Good Friday. The video lasts about an hour and a half. There will not be all-night adoration for April, due to Holy Week schedule. There is adoration on Holy Thursday evening until midnight instead. Holy Saturday is the First Saturday of April – No Communion is possible this day. Therefore, everyone making the First Saturdays has permission to offer their Easter Sunday Communion in reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The other First Saturday requirements – 5 decades of the rosary and the 15 minutes meditation on the mysteries should be done on Holy Saturday. The confession can be done before or after within a reasonable time.


